

 <p>DEFINITION OF CRANE HEIGHT</p>	

Please comply with the following steps when utilizing a crane or temporary construction equipment in order to work in and around the airport.

1. Notification to the airport office must be made at least **48 business hours prior** to the actual work to coordinate the obstruction with the FAA and issue a NOTAM (Notice to Airmen). Please contact the airport office at 386-424-2199.
2. Please give a detailed description of where the cranes location will be during utilization.
3. Please give detailed information regarding crane specifications.

Once approval is given, you must adhere to the following:

1. Equipment will only operate during daylight hours and will be lowered at night.
2. The equipment will only operate during Visual Flight Rules (VFR) conditions, which is 3-mile visibility or greater. If you are not sure, call for the information.
3. The equipment will be lowered to the surrounding height when not in use.
4. The equipment will have 3' square orange and white checkerboard flag on top of the boom.
5. While you are working, if weather conditions impose a hazard to air navigation, you will, upon notification from the airport office, be asked to lower the equipment until weather conditions improve.
